

**SONS OF THE AMERICAN LEGION**  
**Scholarship**  
**Urbana Squadron#71**



The Sons of the American Legion Urbana Squadron #71 Scholarship provides \$500.00 to local citizens who are continuing their education by attending a college leading either to a certification for business or trade or to a college degree. Preference is given to members of Urbana Post 71, Auxiliary Post 71, Post 71 Sons of the American Legion and their children and grandchildren, but applications are invited from any resident of Urbana.

**Rules Governing Scholarship:**

1. Candidate for this scholarship shall be either:
  - a. A member, spouse, child or grandchild of Urbana Post 71, Auxiliary Unit 71 or Squadron 71 SAL.
  - b. Any resident of Urbana.
2. Applicant must be enrolled in a course of study at an accredited institution of higher learning. This may be a four-year college, a junior college, or a business or trade school.
3. The application period will be from May 15, to July 15, 2010.
4. Judging will be done by the officers and members of Sons of the American Legion Squadron #71 as appointed by the scholarship chairman.

**Application Includes:**

- Cover sheet with applicant's name, address and phone number.
- An essay (300-500 words) which reveal the applicant's citizenship and character attributes. **(ALL APPLICATIONS MUST HAVE ESSAY)**
- One letter of sponsorship from a member of Urbana Post 71, Auxiliary Post 71, Squadron 71 SAL, or from a member of the Urbana Community.
